Required "A-G" Courses

a | History/Social Science – 2 YEARS REQUIRED

b | English – 4 YEARS REQUIRED

c | Mathematics – 3 YEARS REQUIRED, 4 YEARS RECOMMENDED

d | Laboratory Science – 2 YEARS REQUIRED, 3 YEARS RECOMMENDED

e | Language Other than English – 2 YEARS REQUIRED, 3 YEARS RECOMMENDED

Two years of the same language other than English.

f | Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) – 1 YEAR REQUIRED

A single yearlong approved arts course from a single VPA discipline: dance, drama/theater, music or visual art.

g | College-Preparatory Electives – 1 YEAR REQUIRED

One year (two semesters), in addition to those required in "a-f" above, chosen from the following areas: visual and performing arts (non-introductory level courses), history, social science, English, advanced mathematics, laboratory science and language other than English.
